

Long Marston Neighbourhood Plan

Following the regulation 14 public consultation by the Parish Council, the neighbourhood plan is now entering its regulation 16 consultation. This is a public consultation undertaken by Stratford District Council who are the qualifying body overseeing the plan.

Responses to the regulation 14 consultation were considered in detail, the plan was modified accordingly and then submitted to SDC as the submission draft for the regulation 16 consultation.

Notice from SDC concerning the consultation: -

“Notice is given that Long Marston Town Council as the Qualifying Body has prepared a Neighbourhood Development Plan entitled the ‘Long Marston Neighbourhood Plan 2011-2031’ for their Town with the help of the local community. The plan sets out a vision for the future of the Town and planning policies which will be used to determine planning applications locally. In accordance with Regulation 16 of Part 5 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended), the Local Planning Authority must publicise the draft plan for a minimum 6-week period inviting representations on the plan.

The consultation starts on Thursday 11th May 2023. Representations on the draft Plan may be made to the District Council by no later than 5pm on Friday 23rd June 2023.
